




Employability details of BAsC graduates after one year from effective date of the degree (2009/2010 Batch)

1. Employability Rate

As shown in the Figure below, 68% of the BAsC graduates from 2009/2010 batch were employed during the one-year period from the effective date of their degree and 27% of them are still searching for a job during the period. Out of unemployed graduates (10), two are following their postgraduate studies.




2. Employability by Sector




A total of 56% of the employed graduates are engaged with private sector employments after one-year period from the effective date of their degree whereas 36% of them are in government and semi-government jobs. In addition, two graduates (8%) had become entrepreneurs.

3. Employability by Gender



A total of 92% of male graduates are employed at the time of data collection, i.e. after one-year period from the effective date of their degree whereas only 54% of female graduates are employed during the same period.

4. Employability by Relevance to the Degree Programme



Majority of the employed graduates (80%) are engaged in employments directly related to the scope of their degree programme.
