




Employability details of BSc graduates after one year from effective date of the degree (2011/2012 Batch)

1. Employability Rate

As shown in the Figure below, 71% of the BSc graduates from 2011/2012 batch are employed during the one-year period from the effective date of their degree (i.e. 13/02/2017) and 21% of them are still searching for a job during the period.




2. Employability by Sector




A total of 53% of the employed graduates are engaged in private sector employments whereas 38% of them are in government and semi-government sector jobs. In addition, two graduates (6%) are self-employed.

3. Employability by Gender



A total of 94% of male graduates are employed at the time of data collection, i.e. after one-year period from the effective date of their degree whereas 59% of female graduates are employed during the same period.

4. Employability by Relevance to the Degree Programme



Majority of the employed graduates (71%) are engaged in employments directly related to the scope of their degree programme.
