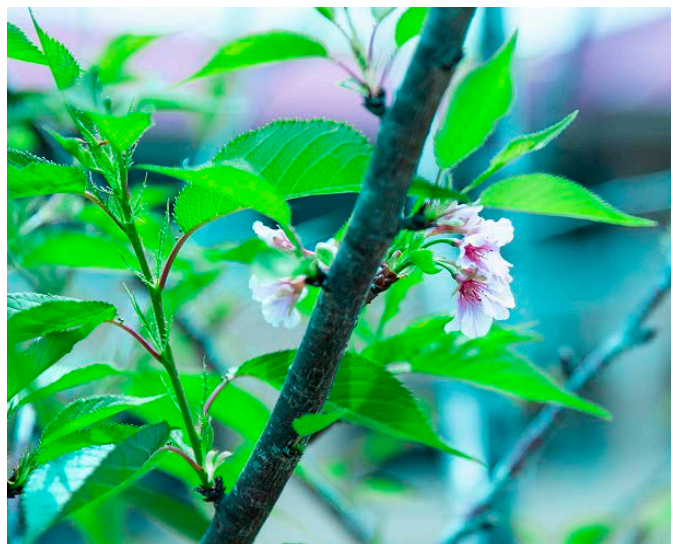

Paving the Learning Through Opportunities

Sakura Blossoms at Uva Wellassa University

Sakura (Japanese Cherry) plants planted in the UWU premises started blooming. These Sakura plants were imported from Japan under a Special Tourism Development Project in collaboration with UWU, Meijo University of Japan and District Secretariat, Badulla. Under the project 10 Sakura plants were brought from Japan and were planted at 7 different climatic and topographical conditions at Uva Province as a pilot research project. Two of the plants were ceremonially planted at UWU on January 3, 2018. Blooming Sakura at UWU has indicated that climatic conditions of Badulla area are conducive with the requirements of Sakura trees. Professor Ananda Kumara of Meijo University of Japan and Dr. P. H. T. Kumara of UWU, Sri Lanka were the Coordinators of the project from Japan and Sri Lanka and Dr. Evon Kaliyadasa, of UWU administered the research work of two plants at the University. Since, the research work was successfully carried out, the project will be upscaled with 1000 Sakura tree planting at Badulla area and developing a new tourism development avenue with a “Sakura Path”.



Reaching New Heights

Finding a new Orchid species



Mr. Champika Bandara, an MPhil student supervised by Professor Sisira Ediriweera Department of Science & Technology, and the team was able to find a new orchid species from the tropical lowland rainforests of Sri Lanka. It is named *Gastrodia gunatillekeorum* (Gastrodieae, Epidendroideae, Orchidaceae). It is morphologically close to *G. spatulata* which is endemic to Indonesia owing to the white flower front with yellowish-orange color on the inner wall, yet had recognizable differences that were scientifically recognized and described by the team. This finding was published in *Phytotaxa*, the World's foremost journal of botanical systematics and biodiversity.

Business Forum 2020 - A Platform to Optimize Business Ideas

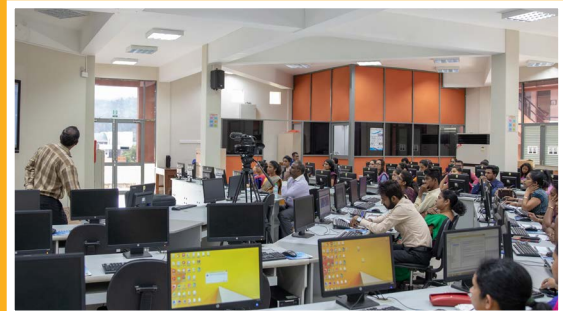

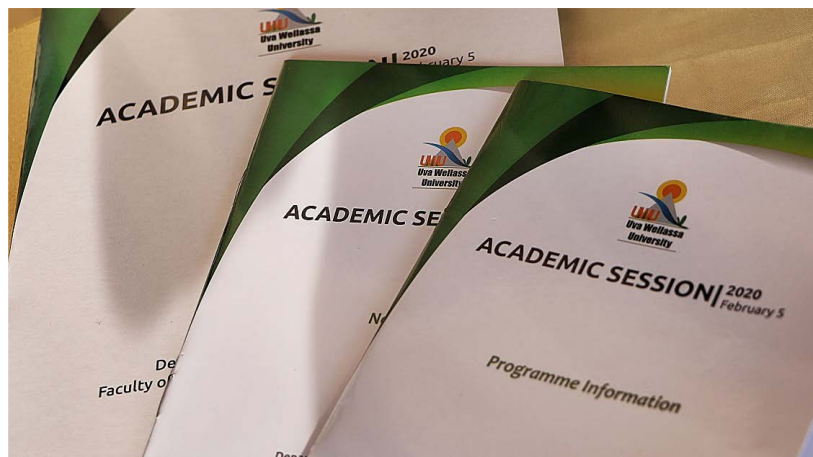


Sri Lanka Forum of University Economists 2020

The Faculty of Management and Department of Export Agriculture coordinated this meeting. UWU was elected as the Chair of the Forum for the year 2020 and Dr. Thusitha Kumara, Faculty of Management, was elected as the Chairman to the SLFUE for 2020.

A research workshop on “Philosophy behind Statistical Hypothesis Testing” and a Panel Discussion on “Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) Compact of Sri Lanka” were held along with the meeting. An eminent scholar and well known political economist, Professor Sumanasiri Liyange, moderated the panel discussion while Dr. Priyanga Dunusinghe, a Senior Lecturer attached to the Department of Economics, University of Colombo made an informative presentation on MCC prior to the panel discussion. Mr. Gevindu Kumarathunga, Ms. Sarasali Fonseka and Mr. Mayura Gunawansa participated as the discussants.





Academic Session 2020 Department of Export Agriculture

The Department of Export Agriculture, Faculty of Animal Science & Export Agriculture organized the Academic Session 2020 for the first time as a collaborative event with the support of AHEAD project (ELTA-ELSE DPs). The event was held on February 6, 2020 at the University Premises. The Session provided a scientific platform for the final year research students to present their research findings who are undergraduates of all three degree programmes of the Department of Export Agriculture: BScHons (Export Agriculture), BScHons (Tea Technology and Value Addition) and BScHons (Palm & Latex Technology and Value Addition).

University Quality Assurance Process Assessment and Dialog



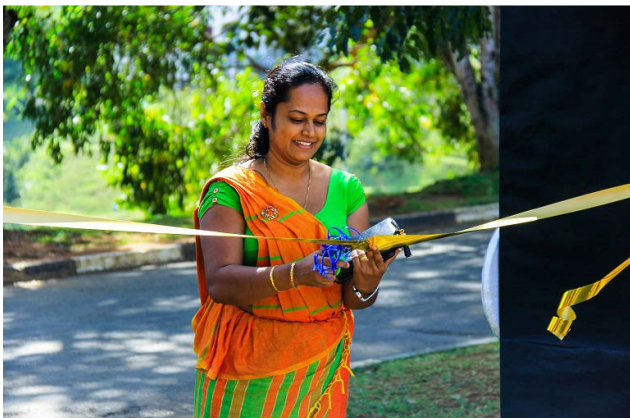

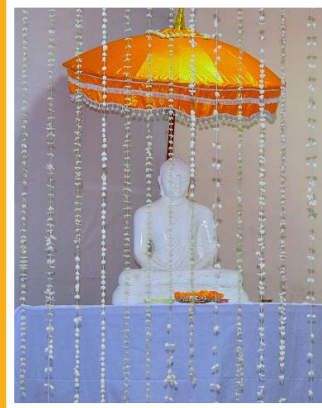




Annual Pirith Chanting Ceremony and Alms Giving of UWU

The awarding ceremony of the Eighth Certificate Course in Teaching in Higher Education (CTHE) was held at the Senate Boardroom of the University on February 19, 2020. The ceremony was graced by Prof. J. L. Ratnasekera, the Vice Chancellor of the UWU, the Deans of Faculties, the Registrar, the Bursar and the Resource Personnel of CTHE course.

The eighth CTHE was commenced on March 15, 2019 and concluded on October 23, 2019 by completing 150 hours of lectures according to the HETC guidelines.
