| 1 | Full article published in a Refereed <i>Non-indexed</i> Journal | Cash Prize Rs. 5,000/= (per article) Maximum Rs. 25,000 /=- | Cash Prize will be divided as following criteria a) Single-authored papers, the author will receive 100% of the marks awarded for the paper. |
| 2 | Full article published in a Refereed <i>Indexed</i> Journal | Cash Prize Rs. 15,000/= (per article) Maximum Rs. 50,000 /=- + Certificate | b) Publications with one additional author will receive 60% of the marks for the first and corresponding author and 40% marks for the second author. c) Publications by more than two authors will receive 40% for the first author and corresponding author and equal balance share for other authors. The minimum award for cash prize will be Rs. 500 /=- |
| 3 | Researcher having the highest citations for the year (One Award for Each Department) | Cash Prize Rs. 25,000/= + Certificate | Research ID (researcherid.com) Scopus ID (scopus.com) Google Scholar (scholar.google.com) <i>Minimum of 20 citations, excluding self-citations are required to qualify</i> |
| 4 | Vice Chancellor's Award for the Most Outstanding Young Researcher of the year | Cash Prize Rs. 50,000/= + Certificate + Trophy | <u>Guidelines for Vice Chancellor's Awards</u> <i>A minimum of 15 marks is required to qualify</i> |
| 5 | Vice Chancellor's Award for the Most Outstanding Senior Researcher of the year | Cash Prize Rs. 60,000/= + Certificate + Trophy | <u>Guidelines for Vice Chancellor's Awards</u> <i>A minimum of 20 marks is required to qualify</i> |
