


Employability details of BASc graduates after one year from effective date of the degree (2012/2013 Batch)

1. Employability Rate

As shown in the Figure below, 77% of the BASc graduates from 2012/2013 batch are employed during the one-year period from the effective date of their degree and 23% of them are unemployed. One unemployed graduate is following a postgraduate study programme.




2. Employability by Sector




A total of 70% of the employed graduates are engaged in private sector employments whereas 24% of them are in government and semi-government sector jobs. In addition, two graduates (6%) had become entrepreneurs.

3. Employability by Gender



A total of 79% of male graduates are employed at the time of data collection, i.e. after oneyear period from the effective date of their degree whereas 77% of female graduates are employed during the same period.

4. Employability by Relevance to the Degree Programme



Majority of the employed graduates (82%) are engaged in employments directly related to their degree programme .
