

## Awards Categories and Criteria for Evaluation

No	Category of Award	Nature of the Award <sup>#</sup>	Criteria
1	Full article published in a Refereed <i>Non-indexed</i> Journal	<b>Cash Prize</b> Rs. 5,000/= (per article) Maximum Rs. 25,000 /=-	Cash Prize will be divided as following criteria 50% for 1 <sup>st</sup> Author
2	Full article published in a Refereed <i>Indexed</i> Journal	<b>Cash Prize</b> Rs. 15,000/= (per article) Maximum Rs. 50,000 /=- + <b>Certificate</b>	25% for corresponding Author 25% for total number of authors in UWU*  *If two or more authors from UWU claims the same article for Research Awards
<p>Examples –</p> <p>if you are the only author for the publication, you will obtain 100% (50+ 25 + 25/1) of the award price</p> <p>If the publication has 2 authors and you are the first author, you will obtain 62.5% (50+ 0+ 25/2) of the award</p> <p>If you are not either the first author or the corresponding author and the publication has 5 authors you will obtain 5% (0+0+ 25/5) of the award cash</p> <p>Award cash less than Rs. 500/= will not be awarded.</p>

4	Vice Chancellor's Award for the Most Outstanding Young Researcher of the year	<b>Cash Prize</b> Rs. 50,000/= + <b>Certificate</b> + <b>Trophy</b>	<u>Guidelines for Vice Chancellor's Awards</u>  <i>A minimum of 15 marks is required to qualify</i>
5	Vice Chancellor's Award for the Most Outstanding Senior Researcher of the year	<b>Cash Prize</b> Rs. 60,000/= + <b>Certificate</b> + <b>Trophy</b>	<u>Guidelines for Vice Chancellor's Awards</u>  <i>A minimum of 20 marks is required to qualify</i>
